This week in Crenver Class – we have all come back raring to go and have had a great week. In Maths we have been looking at fractions and addressing some areas that we found tricky in our assessment. In Literacy we have been looking at simple, complex and compound sentences and have been painting pictures to inspire our work on free form poetry. The children have started to learn about the different ways that vertebrate animals can be sorted and classified in science and have conducted some internet research to learn more about how Easter is celebrated in other Christian communities around the world. The children were delighted to learn that their end of year production this time around will be based on 'Alice in Wonderland' and have started to explore the songs and different characters.

Pengelly - Welcome back for our Summer Term. What a lovely start to the term we have had. The children have produced some exciting writing about what they got up to during the Easter break, making improvements with the help of their 'buddies'. In maths, the children have been writing their own word problems and trying to turn them into 2-step problems. We have also been planning our DT project which is going to be linked to our Geography topic on erosion; we will be having a Geography fieldtrip later on in the year to study the effects of erosion even more closely.

Trenoweth – We hope you all enjoyed your Easter break. It was so lovely to see the children and they have settled back into their learning really well. The children are very excited to be learning about the Sea this term. In maths, we have been learning to tell the time. I have been really impressed with the children's enthusiasm to learn and they have made great progress in just a few days. They have made their own clocks so they can practice at school and at home. In Literacy, we have been doing some descriptive writing about the sea and focusing on our reading comprehension.

Releath – Welcome back! It has been lovely to hear about the wonderful Easter holidays you have all had! We have had a lovely first week, beginning our 'Castles' topic and creating our own princesses and knights. We have been doing lots of maths outside, counting to 100 and planting some of our own vegetables.
